



In this compelling, concise, and insightful history, Bishop Hansen tells the story of the Anglican Province of Christ the King, led by the inspirational Archbishop Robert Sherwood Morse. He describes the dramatic events leading to the St. Louis Congress (1977) and the Denver consecrations (1978), as faithful Anglicans sought to

ensure historic Christian faith and practice. Bishop Hansen recounts the growth of the Diocese and the national Province to become the leading voice for traditional Anglicans in America today. In conclusion, he considers the future of the APCK.

The Rt. Rev. Peter Falconer Hansen, consecrated Bishop Suffragan of the Diocese of the Western States, APCK, in 2017, holds a BA in Architecture (UC Berkeley), an STB in Theology (St. Joseph of Arimathea Anglican Theological College), and is currently rector of St. Augustine of Canterbury Anglican Church in Chico, CA. He has served the APCK since the early '80s as deacon, priest, canon, and bishop.

Bishop Hansen, author of *I Was There, Eyewitnesses at the Foot of the Cross* (Westbow 2014), is currently writing a mystery featuring an Anglican priest and police chaplain. He and his wife have one son and four grandchildren.
